




The Installation Banquet was our first major event and was well attended with over fifty in attendance welcoming Master Brent and the rest of his Officers to the head table.







IN MEMORIAM



Brother Edward "Ed" Minasian Mt. Diablo

Edward "Ed" Minasian died peacefully October 14, 2021. He was born November 6, 1924 in Lawrence, Massachusetts to Toros and Haiganoush Minasian. The son of Armenian genocide survivors, Ed grew up with a fierce pride in his Armenian heritage and strong love for his birth country the United States. After serving in the US Army Air Corps during WWII he studied history at UC Berkeley graduating with honors in 1950. While at Cal he was active in the Armenian Students organization (known then as Alpha Rho Mu) serving as organization president and forming friendships he cherished throughout his life. Upon graduation he began a lifetime career as an educator starting in Oakland at Fremont High and later McClymonds High. In 1956 he embarked on his greatest adventure moving to Nurnberg, West Germany for two years to teach American History at the American air base. While there he travelled extensively visiting over a dozen European countries, parts of the Middle East and even made it past the "Iron Curtain" twice. He continued teaching high school in Oakland when he returned and later enrolled in the Masters program at Berkeley which he completed in 1961. He began teaching American history at Laney College in 1964 and remained there until his retirement in 1993.

Ed was an active member in the Armenian community throughout his lifetime. He served on Parish Council at St. Vartan Church in Oakland, Ca; was a founding member of the Triple X Fraternity Mt. Diablo Chapter; chaired the Norcal Armenian retirement home committee. He authored, "Musa Dagh" which chronicled the influence of the Turkish government and subsequent suppression of the filming of Franz Werfel's "Forty Days of Musa Dagh" in Hollywood.

In 1964 he married Goldie Kuzirian; she was the love of his life. Their marriage was blessed with a son, Edward Toros and lasted 54 years until Goldie's passing in 2018.

Ed is survived by his son, Edward T. (Kristian) Minasian, his nephews, Robert (Karen) Tarpin and Ronald (Dorothy) Ajemian, nieces, Caroline (Robert) Brownson and Roberta Schmitt, and many grand-nieces and nephews.
